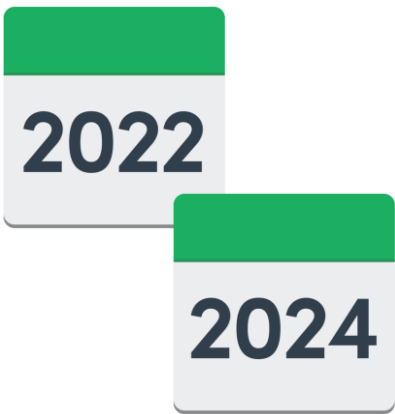
It is about the Web Accessibility Directive.

There are surveys and interviews.

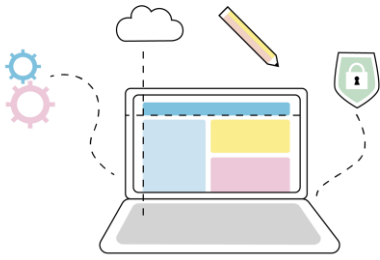


There are workshops.

- How users know about and find websites.



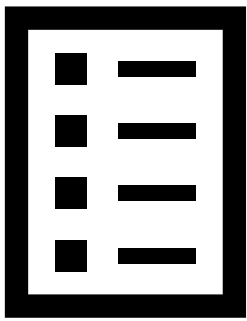
- If websites are accessible.
